OLT is a “just-in-time” provider of professional learning in disability and inclusion for educators, schools, and their executive teams. To accomplish this, we collaborate with disability and inclusion experts, public education systems, Catholic dioceses, independent schools’ associations, and individual schools to develop relevant, high-quality, and research-based courses.

Our courses are accredited against the Australian Professional Standards for Teachers (AITSL) and align with local teacher registration systems across states and territories in Australia. Our mission is to offer professional learning at an affordable cost without compromising on quality or the learning experience.

Our learning model achieves the greatest impact when strategically implemented across a whole-school or education system. Our program includes 12 tutor led e-learning courses that are delivered through a blended model with tutor-led sessions alongside independent online study. Participants engage in small group learning, with cohorts limited to a maximum of 12 individuals. Carefully designed learning activities simulate a school-based approach, enabling participants to effectively connect theory and practice. We train your key people to be course tutors, ensuring that those who know schools best support staff through our courses. Tutors provide support, facilitate discussions, and foster deep learning experiences. The learning cohorts facilitate the sharing of inclusive teaching and learning strategies within a community of practice, ensuring participant engagement and course completion. Some schools have their own dedicated tutor.

Licensed education systems organise our tutored courses and their staff have open access to our short courses.

We also offer two short free courses for parents that anyone can undertake at anytime. These focus on Understanding Autism and Understanding ADHD.
